- Friday and Sunday: Dogs will be run low to high.
- Saturday: Dogs will be run high to low.
- Class order will start with Standard classes, in the order of Excellent, Open and Novice, followed by the JWW classes, in the order of Excellent, Open and Novice. The Preferred classes will be run in conjunction with the regular classes, at the end of each jump height. Mixed breed dogs will run in the appropriate class with other dogs.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC PAL / ILP or Mixed Breed numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 3, Section 22 of the Dog Show Rules. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate (effective 1/1/98 - Section 4 of the Agility Regulations).

### Notice To Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division for regular classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In the Preferred classes, dogs may only be entered in their proper jump height division.
- **Bitches in season and injured dogs** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. **Entry fee will be refunded, less a \$10 per day processing fee, only if accompanied by a vet certification. Requests for refunds MUST be submitted to the trial chairman no later than 5pm, Wednesday, April 7th. See premium list for contact information for the trial chairman.**
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. **Please** help us keep this site clean for future use.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- The Greater Shelby Kennel Club, Inc., its officers and board members, the Trial Secretary, their agents, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors of their dogs or property.
- YOU are responsible for any damage you or your dogs do on the show and/or hotel/motel grounds. Help us continue to offer you a wide selection of places to stay by cleaning up after your dog and ensuring that you, as a responsible dog owner, and your dogs are always welcomed. Trial Committee will be convened for cause.
- Neither the Showplace Arena nor the Greater Shelby Kennel Club will be responsible for dogs and/or property left overnight in the arena.
- RV hookups are available at the show site for \$22 hook- up fee per night, reservations required. See RV section for additional information.
- Coolers with uncontained liquids and ice are NOT permitted on the arena floor.
- **The Trial site will be available to exhibitors for crating purposes at 4:00 pm on Thursday, April 8, 2010.**

## Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through period allows handlers to plan their strategy running the course and will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided.

## Moving Up To The Next Class

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is received by 6:00 pm the Monday before the first day of the trial. Move-ups over the weekend will be accommodated, provided the information is provided before the trial ends each day.

## Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes. Qualifying ribbons/rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores.

Titling Rosettes and Double Q ribbons will be awarded for those who qualify. All placements will be awarded a dog toy valued at \$2. Dogs earning a MACH will receive a rosette and a silver picture frame valued at \$10.

## Jump Height Cards – New Policy

Jump height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has been changed to indicate whether the dog has been issued a temporary or permanent height card, or needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running.

## Important Withdrawal information

## CAMPING AND RV INFORMATION

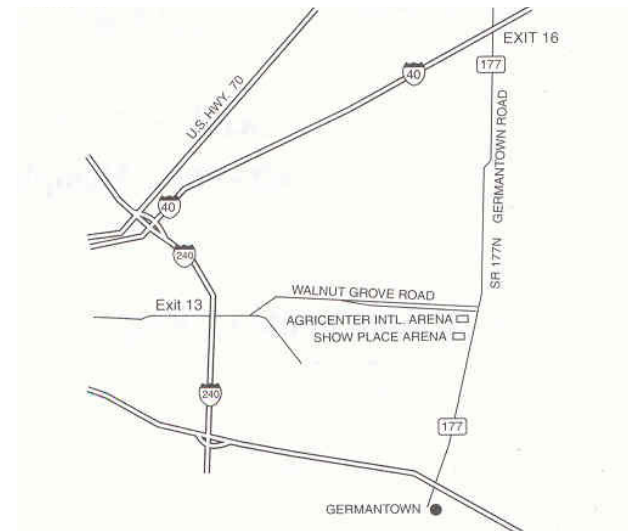

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

**Mixed breed classes** may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? \_\_\_\_\_
