FINAL CONFIRMATION AND JUDGING SCHEDULE

Preliminary email confirmations will be sent upon receipt of entries if a legible email address has been provided. Final confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed unless otherwise expressly requested.

Transfers - The club will allow transfers - refer to rules and regulations, Chapter 1, General Regulations, Section 16a.

Entry of Ineligible Dog - refer to rules and regulations, Chapter 1, General Regulations, Section 16b.

Refunds

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund will be made.

The club may cancel the events due to extreme weather conditions. No entry fee may be returned after entries close, except that of a bitch that comes in season after being entered. A refund less a \$5.00 fee to cover expenses per entry will only be issued if the Trial Secretary receives a Veterinarian's Certificate to this effect at least one hour prior to the start of classes.

Overpayment of fees by \$10.00 and less will be considered a donation to the club and no refund will be issued.

Jump Height Order

Obedience trials will be run in ascending jump height order beginning with the lowest jump height entered in each class both days (except to accommodate handlers with multiple entries). Rally trials will run in ascending order both trials.

Obedience High Jump Height is required for all entries in classes with jumps in the trials. Rally Jump Height is required for Advanced, Excellent, and Master classes.

- [Variety] If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- [Event Class] Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. MOTC Obedience/Rally Trial - COVID-19 Rules – November 26-28, 2021

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and even death. According to the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and those with pre-existing conditions are exceptionally vulnerable. By entering this trial, you voluntarily assume all risks related to COVID-19 exposure.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the following rules will be in place during our trial. These rules will be in effect from the Thursday setup and continue through the end of the trial on Sunday. While we are doing the best we can to make this event as safe as possible, there may still be risk of infection/exposure that we don't know about or cannot control. If you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR if you are unwilling to follow the stated rules, then please do not enter our trial.

Additional rules and regulations are based on recommendations from both the CDC and the AKC.

Masks – Masks will be required to be worn over the nose and mouth at all times while in the building, and while outside within 25 feet of the arena. Please bring at least one mask with you for your personal use. Masks will not be required while you are in the ring running your dog but please put it back on before leaving the ring. Our judge will also be wearing a mask while not in the ring. Please apply 6ft social distancing at all times.

Illness – IF YOU ARE ILL, DO PLEASE NOT COME! If you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days or if you yourself have tested positive in the last 14 days – PLEASE DO NOT COME! Should you or an immediate family member be diagnosed with COVID-19 after the closing date of our trial, your entry payment will be reimbursed.

Ringside - Our goal is to ONLY have the next dog on line and 3 more teams with 6ft spacing ringside. Please wait in the hallway or outside until you are called.

Personal Hygiene - Please wash your hands frequently. If possible, bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer with you. We will endeavor to have larger bottles available for competitors to refill their own bottles if necessary. We will endeavor to have hand sanitizer at each of the Scribe/Timer tables and also at the ribbon table.

Concessions – Concessions will not be available at this trial. Please bring your own food and drink or there are fast-food restaurants within a 5 minute drive of campus.

Leashes - If possible, please think about using a lightweight leash that you can either put in your pocket or tie around your body.

Walkthroughs – We will be limiting the size of walkthroughs if necessary. The final confirmation letter will have an approximate time range, but this may change. Please pay attention to any changes that are announced.

Ribbons - Stickers and a variety of ribbons will also be available on a "self-serve" basis. Again, PLEASE be respectful of social distancing.

Trial Secretary - Please again respect social distancing.

MACH/PACH parties – Unfortunately, for everyone's safety, there will be no MACH/PACH or other celebratory events at this trial. There will not be a central communal table or pens available for MACH/PACH bars to be signed.

Changes to rules – We may make changes to these rules prior to the start of the trial. BE SURE to read your confirmation letter to see what changes have been made. By entering the trial and signing the COVID waiver, you are agreeing to abide by all rules. Failure to follow the rules will be dealt with according to AKC regulations, up to and including requiring you to leave the trial site and bench committee hearings.

With all these additional requirements, we still hope that you and your dog will have fun getting back to competing. Stepping into the ring, it will just be you and your dog and enjoying the thrill our sport offers us. Obviously, it is not as it used to be, but hopefully, with all of us taking individual responsibility for our own actions we will have a safe and enjoyable trial.

MOTC Obedience/Rally Trial - COVID-19 Liability Waiver
