### **RV /Tent Parking:**

**Reservations are required.** RV Hookups – \$25 per night. There are 24 sites available in the RV Lot. Dumping station on site. Limited parking is also available in the barn area (20amps). The RV lot is full, and the spots have been assigned. There is still a waiting list for spots in the RV lot. You will receive a separate email with the RV assignment map, and contact information. No RVs without confirmed reservations are permitted in the RV lot or around the barns. If there is a power problem or water problem at your assigned site, DO NOT SWITCH sites or use the power of a neighboring site. Please report the problem to Kris (information below).

Any damage to the RV site hookups (water or electric) are the responsibility of the person renting the site. Failure to report the damage may result in an event committee hearing. No camping is allowed outside of the barns on MTSU property. The price for tent camping is also \$25 per plug used per night. NOTE: If you move any stall panels when you set up your camping area, you must replace the panels before you leave. MTSU will charge us if they have to replace them.

#### **Directions to Trial Site**

**From I-24**: Exit 78 (Franklin/96 and Lebanon)- exit the interstate and head toward Murfreesboro (east). You are on Old Fort Parkway; this will become Memorial Blvd/Hwy 231, go until you get to the intersection of Memorial and Clark Blvd. (BP gas and U-Haul on corner). Turn right on Clark, go to the intersection of Clark and Greenland Dr. and turn left. Parking in front of the arena is on the right past the 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light.

**From I-40**: From west or east take the Lebanon exit for Highway 231 and head south toward Murfreesboro (from Nashville turn right, from Knoxville turn left). This is Memorial Blvd when you get into Murfreesboro. Go to the intersection of Memorial and Clark and turn left. Go to Greenland Dr. and turn left. Parking in front of the arena is on the right past the 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light.

## PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG(S)!!

#### Other Items of Interest:

- The building will be open for set up **AFTER 3 PM** on Thursday, before the trial. If you plan to help with the ring set up and trailer unloading, you may set up as early as noon on Thurs. Any set ups prior to noon may be moved at the club's discretion.
- RVs may arrive any time after noon on Thursday.
- There is no check in required. Handlers with dogs that need to be measured are responsible for having their dogs measured before their first run of the weekend. Failure to do so could result in qualifying runs being taken away. Exhibitors alone are responsible for obtaining a measurement, you will not be sought out to receive it. There will be an AKC Volunteer Measuring Official on site to measure for height cards.
- Exhibitors are responsible for any items left at the show site.
- Move-ups must be provided to the Trial Secretary in writing (fax, email or US Mail) by Monday prior to the trial at 6 pm. Move ups resulting from this trial will be accepted from day to day.

#### **Important Exhibitor Notice**

At the previous trial, we had a couple of incidents in the small ladies room that has showers. In each case, the offending party did not notify the facility of the occurrence. I happened upon one of them and was reporting the problem to the facility when I saw the exhibitor leave the restroom without reporting it. The second was reported by another exhibitor. In the second incident, one of the exhibitors had apparently clipped and bathed their dog in the shower the previous evening, causing it to stop up. The facility found handfuls of dog hair blocking the drain of the shower. This type of behavior can cause **all clubs to lose the use of this wonderful facility**. If something happens, PLEASE report it to the Trial Secretary or the Trial Chair so that we can address it immediately with the facility. Failure to report an incident can result in either a request for the offending party to vacate the facility, or an event committee hearing, or both.

# Schedule (Friday - Sunday)

- Friday and Sunday will run low to high, Saturday will run high to low.
- The Standard ring will start at 8 am each day, and the JWW ring will start at 9 am Friday and Saturday, and 8:30 on Sunday. See the timeline at the end for estimated class start times. Please be aware that the times shown are only an estimate. Oher than the first class of the day in each ring, classes may start before or after the estimated time shown.
- All FAST classes will walk at the same time and then run together by jump height. The walk order will be determined the day of the trial.
- The first Judge's briefing will be approximately 15 minutes before the ring's start time.

#### Judging Assignments and Class Order:

Space is tight around the rings. To avoid congestion and ensure the safety of dogs and handlers, please observe the following:

- If you're not running your dog, **please don't gather around the rings**. Please sit in the stadium seating if you're not running your dog.
- Please keep your dog back from the ring until there are no more than five dogs ahead of you. Before this time, you can wait in the hallway area for jumpers or the ramp area for standard.
- When you wait to walk the course with your height, please avoid gathering at ringside until there are three dogs left to run of the previous jump height. Please do not enter the ring until the last dog running has left the ring.
- After you run the course, please remove your dogs from the ring area as soon as possible. If you want to reward your dogs, please take your treats from the "treat table" and move your dogs out of the arena to reward them.

#### **VOLUNTEER INFORMATION**

Volunteers who work a full class, or a partial class that is split, will receive a \$3 voucher that can be used for vendors at the trial or the food truck, or for future entries. You may sign up at this link: <u>MOTC Worker Link</u>

Dogs are allowed in the seating areas of the arena with their owners/handlers. No crating is allowed in any of the seating areas, but dogs may sit on lead in the seating areas on either end of the arena - except for the first rows. No dogs or people allowed in the rows immediately next to the ring.

CRATING will be available in a room adjacent to the arena and in the dirt warm up room. No ex-pen "living rooms" will be allowed. If you put crates inside an ex-pen, you will be asked to remove the ex-pen. Ex-pens may be used for two or more dogs.

We will NOT have a food truck for this weekend. No concessions available on site.
