Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

FEO Runs will be offered for T2B and FAST.

Notice To Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes may **not** run in a higher height division.
- **Bitches in season and injured dogs** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$5 processing fee per run **with a certificate from a veterinarian**.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs**. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. **Please** help us keep this site clean for future use.
- Please do not allow your dogs off lead when you are walking them. The farm has livestock that may be loose. Do not allow your dogs to chase or lunge at the livestock.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee as assessed by the bank to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- **Concessions will NOT be available on site and there are no restaurants nearby.** We will NOT be able to provide bottled water or lunch for workers. **Please bring your own food and water with you.**
- The show site will not be available for set up until the day of the trial. The final confirmation will list the time.
- **No RV parking. Parking for oversize vehicles will be down the hill from the arena.**
- There is limited crating space inside the arena. Parking next to the arena will be limited to those who are keeping their dogs in their vehicles.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through period allows handlers to plan their strategy running the course and will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Moving Up To the Next Class

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing **no later than Wednesday September 30th, per AKC regulations, Chapter 1, section 20.**

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. New Titling Ribbons will be offered for those finishing a title (with the exception of the new Master Bronze, Silver, Gold and Century titles). Special AGCH, MACH, PACH, PAX, MX, MXJ and QQ ribbons will also be provided.

Waiting list

A waiting list of up to 50 runs will be maintained. Per Chapter 1, Section 16.1 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a "waiting list close date" will be instituted. **The "waiting list close" will be 6 pm, Saturday, October 3.** Full refunds will be given to those exhibitors withdrawing **ONLY for the runs that can be filled from the waiting list.**

DIRECTIONS TO NEVER GO BACK RANCH

From: Nashville/ Lebanon/ Wilson County Exposition Center:

Take exit 239A onto to US-70 east toward Watertown. .4 mi. turn right onto Maddox Simpson Parkway. .4 mi. turn left on Cainesville Rd., 7.1 mi. turn left on Beech Log Rd., 2.3 mi. turn left into farm.

If using your GPS: Some GPS's bring you off Sparta pike to Beech Log. That is very winding back way, and it's easy to get lost. It's easier to enter the coordinates for the corner of Beech Log Rd and Cainesville Rd: N 36 degrees 05.448' W 086 degrees 14.191'.

From Franklin / 840:

Take exit 65 (TN 452E). Turn right.
Travel 4.4 miles to Highway 231N (TN 452E ends at the stop sign). Turn left.
Travel 5.8 miles to TN 265E (Chicken Road). Turn right.
Travel 5.4 miles to TN 266S (Cainesville Pike). Turn right.
Travel 1.4 miles to Beech Log Road. Turn left.
Travel 2.5 miles to show site on the left, 3337 Beech Log Road.

From Murfreesboro:

Take Highway 96 Lacassas Pike (East) to TN 266S (Cainesville Pike). Turn left.
Travel 12 miles to Beech Log Road. Turn right. (If you come to Rt 265, you have gone too far.)
Travel 2.5 miles to show site on the left, 3337 Beech Log Road.

From Show Site, take TN-265-W to US 231S, turn left onto US 231S, get on TN-840 W in Rutherford County; continue on TN 840 W to Murfreesboro. Take exit 78A from I-24E. Turn left on Cason Lane then immediate left onto River Rock Blvd.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations

Jump Height Cards

Jump height cards are not required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form includes a spot to indicate whether the dog has been issued a temporary or permanent height card, or needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running, either by the judge or record or by a VMO or AKC rep if present.

- **Please circle class AND jump height. 50% of the entries coming in are missing one of these fields.**
- Please write legibly!
- Please double check the total due before writing the check. This will save the treasurer a great deal of trouble writing refunds. **Any overpayments in the amount of \$5 or less will NOT be refunded.**
- Make sure you submit both sides of the form. Your signature is required on the back of the form. **Any unsigned entries may not be accepted and must be returned.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____

MOTC COVID STATEMENT 10/07/20

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the following rules will be in place during our trial. These rules will be in effect from the setup and continue through the end of the trial. While we are doing the best we can to make this event as safe as possible, there may still be risk of infection/exposure that we don't know about or cannot control. If you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR if you are unwilling to follow the stated rules, then please do not enter our trial.

Additional rules and regulations are based on recommendations from both the CDC and the AKC.

Masks – Masks will be required to be worn over the nose and mouth at all times while in the building, and while outside within 50 feet of the arena. Please bring at least one mask with you for your personal use. The only exceptions will be while you are in the ring running your dog. You may put the mask in your pocket as you step to the line with your dog and put it back on as soon as you are done with the run. Our judge will NOT be wearing a mask while in the ring, but ask that if exhibitors need to talk to him, PLEASE WEAR your mask. Judge WILL be wearing a mask when NOT in the ring. Please apply 6ft social distancing at all times.

Illness – IF YOU ARE ILL, DO PLEASE NOT COME! If you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to the event date(s)– PLEASE DO NOT COME! Exhibitors – We are limiting this trial to exhibitors only. The general public will not be allowed to watch, in an effort to limit the total number of people onsite. Should you or an immediate family member be diagnosed with COVID-19 after the closing date of our trial, your entry payment will be reimbursed MINUS a \$5 administration fee per run.

Ringside - Our goal is to ONLY have the next dog on line and 3 more teams with 6ft spacing ringside. Please wait in the hallway or outside until you are called.

Personal Hygiene - Please wash your hands frequently. If possible, bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer with you. We will endeavor to have larger bottles available for competitors to refill their own bottles if necessary. Hand sanitizer will be at each of the Scribe/Timer tables and also at the ribbon table.

Concessions – Concessions will not be available at this trial. Please bring your own food and drinks.

Leashes - If possible, please think about using a lightweight leash that you can either put in your pocket or tie around your body.

Walkthroughs – We will be limiting the size of walkthroughs if necessary. The final confirmation letter will have an approximate time range, but this may change. Please pay attention to any changes that are announced.

Ribbons - Stickers and a variety of ribbons will also be available on a "self-serve" basis, but there will be "Xs" on the floor to indicate 6ft spacing. Again, PLEASE be respectful of social distancing.

Trial Secretary - Please again respect social distancing. A 6ft mark will be placed on the floor.

MACH/PACH parties – Unfortunately, for everyone’s safety, there will be no MACH/PACH Or other celebratory events at this trial. There will not be a central communal table or pens available for MACH/PACH bars to be signed.

Doors – We will mark doors as “In” or “Out” wherever possible. This is to reduce cross-traffic. Please follow the instructions on these signs.
