PLEASE NOTE:

Due to damage incurred at a previous trial, absolutely **NO loading or unloading, crates or dollies** may pass through ANY facility door that has glass in it. This includes all doors on the long sides of the building. You may enter from the barn side of the building and come up the elevator to the crating area OR there are two entry doors on the opposite end of the building where there is RV parking. This is an Ag Center rule, and it will be enforced. Failure to comply may result in a bench committee hearing.

Be sure not to park in a reserved spot or under the covered area unless you've reserved covered parking.

When making reservations, please verify with the hotels their policies on accepting pets and their pet fees.

RV Parking

RV Parking is available ONLY on a reserved, prepaid basis. There are 16 30- and 50-amp hookups on the hill on the east side of the arena and lots of 30-amp hookups in the barn area. Hookups are \$20 per night, payment due with entry. If you use two 30 amp spots, or a 30 amp and a 20 amp to create a 50 amp connection, you will be charged for two spots, or \$40 per night. The facility does not count RVs, they count the number of outlets being used. **EXCEPT for spaces reserved by NDTC for workers or judges, there are no assigned spots, it is first come beginning at noon on Wednesday.**

Directions to Trial Site

From I-65 (south of Nashville):

- Take exit # 61, Peytonsville Rd.
- Go east on Peytonsville Rd.
- TURN LEFT at the first street, which is Long Lane. Facility is on the right.

On Call Veterinarian:

Emergency care: Blue Pearl Veterinary Partners, 3020 Mallory Lane, Franklin, TN 37067. 615-333-1212. Take I-65 to Exit 67 and turn west. Turn right on Mallory Lane. Clinic is approximately 0.8 mile on the right before you get to Cool Springs Blvd.

Notes:

- The building will be open for exhibitor set up **after 1:00 pm on Wednesday** before the trial. It will be closed at 8 p.m. **No crates or dollies may be brought in through ANY glass doors as detailed above, and NO DOGS may be brought in through the front doors** to get to the potty area. Set up may begin **NO EARLIER** than 1:00 pm. Those helping with ring setup may come at 11 AM. Please see the crating instructions below.
- The building will open at 6 am on Thursday through Sunday and will close at 8 pm.
- Exhibitors with dogs that need to be measured are responsible for ensuring that their dog is measured prior to their first run of the weekend. Failure to do so may result in removal of qualifying runs. There will be several AKC Volunteer Measuring Officials on site to measure for height cards.
- Move-ups must be provided to the Trial Secretary in writing (fax, email, or US mail) by 6:00 pm on Monday before the trial. Move ups resulting from this trial will be accepted from day to day provided they are submitted by the end of the last class each day.
- We still need volunteers to help work! Volunteers will be provided with vouchers that can be used at vendor booths, the food truck, or for future NDTC entries.

AgilityGate will be used at this trial. Trial code is 0123.

There will be a food truck available during the trials.

Schedule (all Days)

- Thursday and Saturday: Dogs will be run high to low. Friday and Sunday: Dogs will be run low to high
- **Thursday, Friday, and Saturday:** FAST will run first in the Std ring by jump height order, with all levels running together. This will be followed by Std classes in the order of Premier, Exc/Master, Open and Novice. T2B will run first in the JWW ring followed by JWW classes in the order of Novice, Open, Exc/Master, and Premier.
- **Sunday:** Std ring will run in the order of Premier, Exc/Master, Open, and Novice. JWW Ring will run in the order of Novice, Open, Exc/Master, and Premier.
- First Judge's briefing will be approximately 15 minutes before the ring start time.
- Std Ring will start at 8 am each day, and the JWW ring will start at 9:00 am Thursday, Friday and Saturday, and at **8 am on Sunday**.

Early crating and setup – Please check times!

As stated in the **Notice to Exhibitors** section, the building will be open for crating at 3 PM. For the Club to ensure there are plenty of workers to unload the equipment trailer, we will allow early crating for workers who help with unloading and ring set up. We know that some people like to drop by the trial site early to set up their crating areas, but don't have the time or ability to help with the trailer unloading and ring set up. NDTC will once again allow early crating for a fee of \$10 per mat.

If you want to set up your crates early and you cannot stay to help unload the trailer, you will be charged \$10 per mat that you put down. **Early crating time will be 11 AM – 1 PM. Unloading/ring set-up for agility will begin at 3 PM.**

If you **can** volunteer to help unload the trailer and set up the rings, you will:

- Not be charged for early set up!
- Get worker bucks!
- Be entered in a drawing for 1 free day of entries for 1 dog to any NDTC future agility trial!
- Be entered in cash drawings!
- Earn our undying gratitude!
- Help us set a new record for speed of unloading and setup!

We will have committee members at the site to monitor the entrance door, collect money, and keep the names of the volunteers willing to help prepare for the trial.
