Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

FEO Runs will be offered for FAST and T2B at this trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an ILP/PAL number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. This event is accepting entries for dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

Moving Up To The Next Class

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made by 6 pm, the Monday before the trial.. Move-ups over the weekend will be accommodated, provided the information is provided before the trial ends each day.

Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores.

Jump Height Cards

Jump height cards are not required to be submitted with the entry form. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running. Important Notice To Exhibitors

We would like this event to be a pleasant experience for all in attendance. We ask your cooperation, please, in the following areas:

1. This trial will be held under AKC rules and regulations for agility trials. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with these rules and regulations.
2. The trial site will be open to participants starting at 2:00 pm, Thursday, the day before the first day of the trial. All dogs and personal belongings must be removed by one hour after the trial ends on Sunday.
3. Participants who leave dogs, equipment and personal belongings unattended, do so at their own risk. The show giving club(s) and the owner(s) of the site will not be responsible for dogs, equipment or personal belongings, nor for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog, whether the result of accident or any other cause.
4. NO ALCOHOL will be permitted anywhere on the premises or grounds and NO SMOKING will be permitted in the building. Please respect this site!
5. All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates at all times except when competing. Dogs (even on leash) are not permitted in the concessions area.
6. Ample parking and areas for crating dogs. RV hookups available by prior reservation only.
7. Food concessions may be available during the trials. You will be notified in final confirmation letter.
8. Participants will be responsible for clean conditions (including picking up after the dogs in their care) around crates, parking spaces and hookups.
9. Bitches in season and injured dogs shall not be eligible to participate. Partial refunds (minus \$5 per run) will be given for bitches in season. A letter from a veterinarian on their letterhead is required by the Trial Chair prior to the beginning of the trial for a refund.
10. Dogs must be ready to compete. The judge need not wait for any dog that is not ready to compete when the gate steward calls its number.
11. The judges will take a half-hour lunch break at a convenient time.
12. Participants shall be governed by any rules and regulations of civil authorities and/or location restrictions. Please obey all posted signs.
13. Parents or guardians must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision of an adult at all times.
14. Vehicles will be allowed to park in designated areas only. Vehicles parked in undesignated areas will be towed at the owner's expense.
15. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check.
16. Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
17. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

The Trial site will be available to exhibitors at 3:00 PM till 8:00 PM on Thursday before the trial. NO EXCEPTIONS. All dogs and personal belongings must be removed by one hour after the trial ends on Sunday.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided.

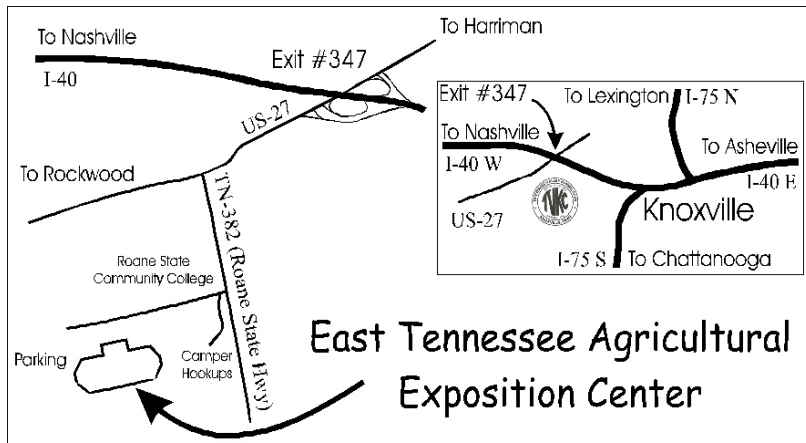
MAP & DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From Knoxville: Take I-40 West towards Nashville. Go about 35 miles and take the US-27 exit (Exit #347). Turn LEFT onto US-27 and go 2.3 miles. Follow "From US-27" below.

From Nashville: Take I-40 East towards Knoxville. Go about 130 miles and take the US-27 exit (Exit #347). Keep LEFT at the fork in the exit ramp. Turn LEFT onto US-27 and go 2.1 miles. Follow "From US-27" below.

From Chattanooga: Take I-75 North towards Knoxville. Go about 85 miles and take the I-40 West exit (LEFT fork). Go about 20 miles and take the US-27 exit (Exit #347). Turn LEFT onto US-27 and go 2.3 miles. Follow "From US-27" below.

From US-27: To TN-382 and Roane State Community College (RSCC). Turn LEFT onto 382 towards RSCC. Go 1.0 miles, passing RSCC on the right, and immediately turn RIGHT towards the Expo Center parking areas. The Expo Center will be on your left. Follow signs to competitor's parking areas on the north and west sides of the building. Do not block driveways on the arena level entrances! **Camper hookups** are on the east side of the building. When you turn RIGHT off TN-382, make an immediate LEFT. Follow signs for camper hookups.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

COVID-19 Rules

Please read this carefully. Your entry to this trial is contingent upon you agreeing to abide by these rules and indicating your agreement by signing the attached waiver.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the following rules will be in place during the trial.

We will be adhering to these rules beginning on the first day of the trial (Friday) and continuing through all 3 days of the trial and tear down on Sunday. While we are doing the best we can to make this event as safe as possible, there may still be risk of infection/exposure that we don't know about or cannot control. If you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR if you are unwilling to follow the stated rules, it would be best if you did not enter this trial.

These rules are based on information from the CDC and following consultation with the AKC. **Please be aware** that infractions of these rules will be dealt with according to AKC regulations, up to and including requiring you to leave the trial site and bench committee hearings.

Masks – Solid masks will be required to be worn over the nose and mouth at all times while in the building. Please bring at least one mask with you for your personal use. (Face shields are not an acceptable alternative to masks.) The only exceptions will be while you are in the ring running your dog. You may put the mask in your pocket as you step to the line with your dog and put it back on as soon as you are done with the run. **No exceptions.** Please apply 6-foot social distancing at all times.

Illness – IF YOU ARE ILL, DO NOT COME! If you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days – DO NOT COME! Should you or someone you live with be diagnosed with COVID-19 after the closing date of our trial, your entry fees will be reimbursed, less AKC fees.

Handwashing – Please wash your hands as often as possible. We will do our very best to have hand sanitizer available, but cannot guarantee our ability to provide it for you because of shortages. Please bring hand sanitizer with you for your own use.

Crating – Please allow 6 feet between crating areas. If you have more than one crate, please try to consolidate your crating area as much as possible to allow for more space between people. If a member of the trial committee asks you to move your setup, please do so immediately. Crating set up and spacing will be an individual responsibility. PLEASE be considerate to your fellow competitors and respect them as you would wish to be respected. If the Committee members see "crating encroachment" you will be asked to move.

MACH/PACH parties – Unfortunately, for everyone's safety, there will be no MACH/PACH or other celebratory events at this trial. There may be a central communal table or pens available for MACH/PACH bars to be signed, but we ask you to be respectful of social distancing and personal space.

Changes to rules – We may make changes to these rules prior to the start of the trial. BE SURE to read your confirmation letter to see what changes have been instated.

In order to hold this trial, these are the compromises we must make, based on information from the CDC and following consultation with the AKC. **Please be aware** that infractions of these rules will be dealt with according to AKC regulations, up to and including requiring you to leave the trial site and bench committee hearings.
