Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. As of 7/1/24, FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an
 ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and
 must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes
 are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

FEO Runs will be offered for all classes.
